At the turn of the 20th century a gentleman called Henry Forbes-Witherby came to The New Forest from London. Mr Witherby decided to have a country house built within 11 acres of this beautiful area, he named his house Holmehurst.

At the time of the Great War Holmehurst disappears from the pages of history, this suggests that the house was most likely taken over by the war effort. During the 2nd World War it is known that the Army used Holmehurst, the House was part of a Hospital complex that also included Lynford House in Bisterne Close. During this time the Green Howards, The 2nd Tank Regiment and many others, occupied Holmehurst. The presence of the military added to the unfortunate damage caused by German air force machine gun fire, the evidence of which is said to still be visible.

In 1955 the house was opened by new owners the Lawford family as 'The Holmehurst Hotel', the main custom of this friendly family run business was tourists visiting the New Forest. When the need to generate more business became paramount the family sought a new name and image, John Lawford stumbled upon the perfect new name by complete chance. After enjoying a drink in The Queens Head with a cricketing colleague, John was cycling home past Burley golf club when a white animal speeding off into the forest startled him. On relating the story when he got back home it was revealed that there was a white buck in the area so the new name was found and the Hotel became 'The White Buck'.

Today Chris & the team continue to promote the same warm and friendly atmosphere of a traditional New Forest Inn at The White Buck, offering a varied and tempting selection of home cooked food, fine wines from around the world and a varied choice of Fuller's award-winning ales.

STELLAR ORGANIC FAIR TRADE CHENIN SAUVIGNON

With a great mixture of tangy guava fruit flavours, honey and flowers. Dry with a crisp finish.

EL COTO RIOJA, SPAIN

Rioja Blanco from the Viura grape variety delivers a crisp, dry style. With an intense bouquet of acacia & apple. Followed by delicious flavours in the mouth with notes of sweet citrus fruit.

PINOT GRIGIO VILLA CERRO, ITALY

From the sunny hills of Veneto, this is a dry white wine from a classic grape variety. Straw yellow in appearance, this is a generous, well-balanced wine with rich, fruity fragrances and a crisp freshness on the palate.

CHABLIS DOMAINE DE VAUROUX, FRANCE

A true classic, dry yet full of soft ripe rich fruit with a balanced savoury nuttiness at the finish, from a top Domaine. A must for those Burgundy lovers!

SANCERRE DOMAINE DURAND LOIRE, FRANCE

A seductive Sauvignon with the aroma of gooseberries and classic gunflint flavours. A fine example from the Loire Valley. Dry & crisp with an elegant finish

SEMILLON 'THE COLONIAL ESTATE' BAROSSA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA

This is a small estate purchased by the owner of Chateau Teyssier in Saint Emilion. He is now becoming a flying winemaker, and produces super wines in both hemispheres. Rich ripe honeydew melon and exotic fruits followed by sweet summer berries and complimented by soft French oak. A must try...

RED WINES

VERANDA CABERNET/CARMENERE, CHILE

This wine aged in French oak barrels for twelve months presents a deep dark ruby, with a complex nose notably featuring ripe cherry & cassis with a touch of spicy black pepper

MERLOT HACIENDA DEL REY CANATA, CHILE

The wine has an intense flavour of cherries, raspberries and even chocolate! Followed by a spicy well-balanced harmonious and complex finish. Definitely a wine to tempt the taste buds.

STELLAR ORGANIC FAIR TRADE SHIRAZ, SOUTH AFRICA

A medium bodied red, soft and spicy with plenty of berry fruit and a hint of white pepper on the finish.

DARIEN CRIANZA RIOJA, SPAIN

£5.05 £7 £21

A wonderfully balanced wine, this Rioja has beautiful red berry and cherry flavours. Aged for one year on American & French oak barrels adds complex notes of smoke and toast. The structure and balance make this wine a perfect companion to any meal.

PINOT NOIR TRIVENTO, ARGENTINA

Bags of ripe berry and cherry fruit characters. Absolutely delicious, fresh light red.

COTES DU RHONE DOMAINE DE LA GRIVELIERE, FRANCE

Hints of fruit and spice on the nose lead to a palate infused with a touch of liquorice and vanilla. Well-rounded and easy-drinking.

BROKEN BARREL HILL BLACK SHIRAZ £20

Long, warm, sunny Australian, dry days help to ripen fruit to the point of berry shrivel, which concentrates the fruit. A robust wine that is rich and generous yet smooth on the palate. Black cherry and plum characters are beautifully balanced by soft oak culminating in an enjoyable long finish.

CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE DOMAINE ROGER PERRIN RHÔNE £30

Full of spice & pepper, displaying the power & exuberant rich fruit typical of this Rhône village. Dry, with plenty of flavours & a perfect finish. From a producer famous for making top quality wine albeit in small quantities.

BAROLO PIEDMONT, ITALY £37

Marvellous flavours of violets, prunes, and bitter chocolate with emerging roses. Rich full bodied with distinctive oakiness and marked acidity which becomes coated in velvety richness.

CHATEAU CLERC MILON SEME CRU CLASSE PAUILLAC 1998 £42

Impressively structured and with much elegance and complexity the wines can be drunk relatively young, although they do have the ability to age well.
